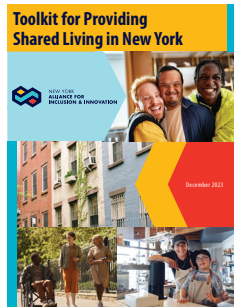


Housing Resource Guide:

The Housing Resource Guide was first published in 2012 and has been revised several times since. This latest revision addresses the new regulations for OPWDD’s Housing Subsidy, adds new resources created by the Housing Resource Center and updates links to federal State and local resources. For Housing Navigators this edition aligns with the Housing Planning Instrument and the sequence of the Housing Navigation training.



Shared Living Toolkit (NEW)

For purposes of this Toolkit, shared living encompasses both persons who live together in the same four walls and those who live quite near to one another (e.g. in adjacent apartments). These are referred to as live-with and live-near support arrangements. This Toolkit is neither a research nor an advocacy document. Rather, it is designed to assist provider organizations on the very specific “how-to’s” of developing and supporting shared living. It focuses especially on how to access funding, tax considerations, wage and hour concerns and the control of property.



DDPC Housing Grant: Housing Navigation Final Report 2023

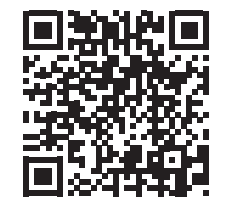
In 2019, the New York Alliance for Inclusion and Innovation (NY Alliance) was awarded a three-year housing grant from the New York State DDPC. Included in the grant was the creation of a “Master Housing Navigator” (MHN) to provide housing navigation services to people with I/DD seeking to live more independently. Despite significant disruption to services arising from the Covid-19 pandemic, 29 people were able to successfully transition, with 9 other people close to completing their housing journey when the project concluded.

The participants reported a significant increase in their autonomy and quality of life. In addition the project demonstrated a significant decrease in state expenditure.

The NY Alliance issued a preliminary report in March of 2022. This final report summarizes the work and the outcomes of the Pilot Project, including finalized data on financial outcomes.
