- Re: COVID-19: Reporting Confirmed Cases

As the number of COVID-19 cases in Kentucky continues to grow, the Department for Medicaid Services (DMS) recognizes the chance a 1915(c) Home and Community Based Services (HCBS) waiver participant or agency employee may contract the virus.

If you have a waiver participant and/or an employee who provides direct services to waiver participants test positive for COVID-19, DMS is asking you to submit a critical incident report. You should follow the same procedures you would in reporting any critical incident.

When submitting a critical incident report about a waiver participant or agency employee's COVID-19 diagnosis, **please include** "**COVID-19**" in the subject line of the email. Your critical incident report should also include the following information:

- The steps being taken to isolate and care for the waiver participant and/or agency employee diagnosed.
- The steps being taken to prevent the spread of COVID-19 to other waiver participants and/or agency employees.
- In the case of an agency employee contracting COVID-19, please indicate if the employee had contact with waiver participants and/or if they had contact with other agency staff who have contact with waiver participants.
