

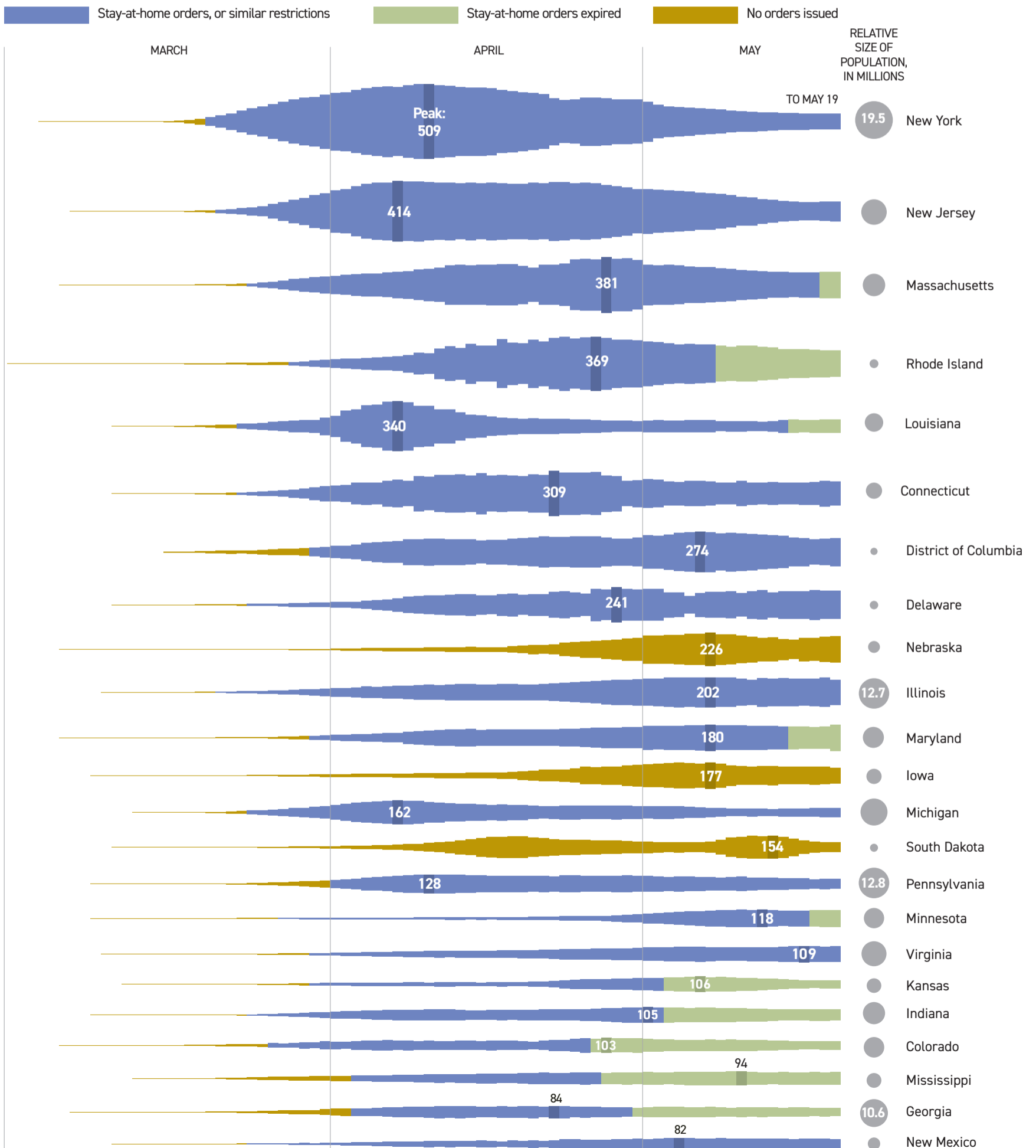

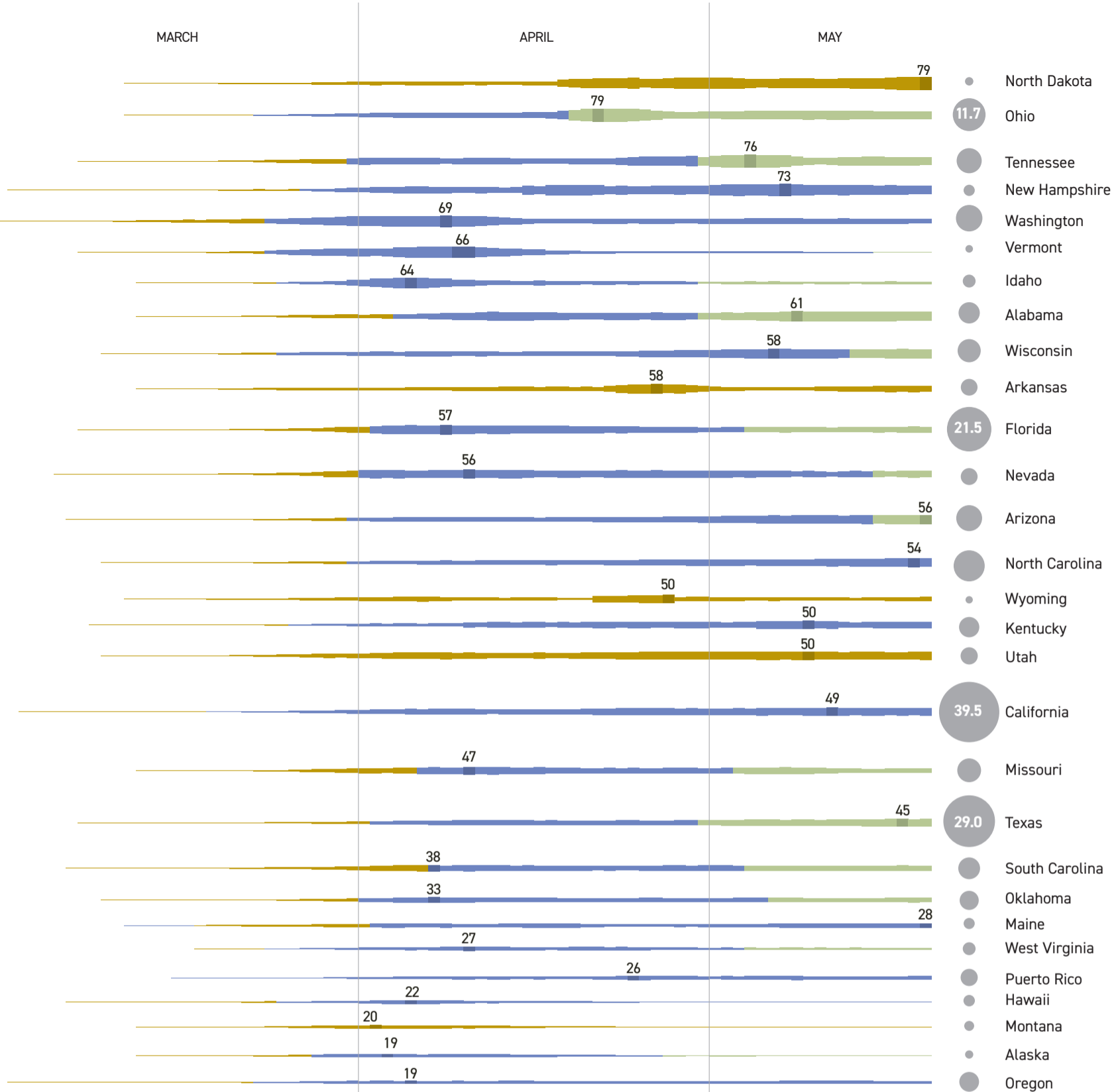
States vary widely in how Covid-19 has infected populations

In northeastern states hardest hit by the coronavirus pandemic, infection rates peaked in April. Many other states saw their highest rates in May, while a handful of states have infection rates that are still growing — or are on the rebound after diminishing.
