What is the Leadership Academy?

Building on its previous leadership development programs, the ANCOR Foundation launched the Leadership Academy in 2017 to nurture emerging leaders who are building their careers in services and supports for people with intellectual and developmental disabilities (I/DD).

Over the course of two years, the Foundation provides training and mentoring opportunities to support mid-career professionals in cultivating their areas of expertise and thought leadership to build influence and reputation in the national I/DD community as the next generation of leaders.

Who is It For?

The Leadership Academy is best suited for individuals who have at least five years of experience in the field (with at least one year of supervisory experience) and are looking to pursue (or are new to) executive and management positions in organizations that supports people with intellectual and developmental disabilities.

How Much Does It Cost to Participate?

If accepted, fees for the two-year program are \$1,500 per participant.

Because of the significant value for the program, the Leadership Academy is only available to ANCOR members at this time.

How Can I Apply?

We will begin accepting applications for our third cohort on October 1, 2021. Applications for this cohort will be due no later than 11:59 pm PST on December 15, 2021.

Applicants who are accepted into the program will be notified in February 2022. The program will begin with an orientation in March 2022 and participants in the third cohort will be celebrated during a graduation ceremony at the 2024 ANCOR Annual Conference.
